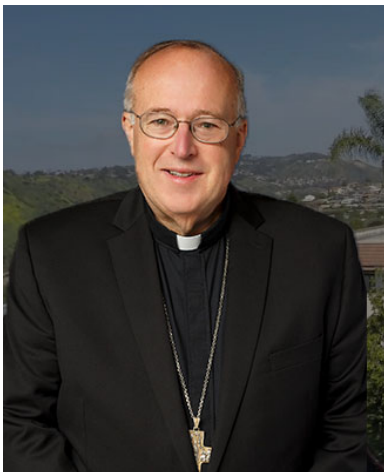

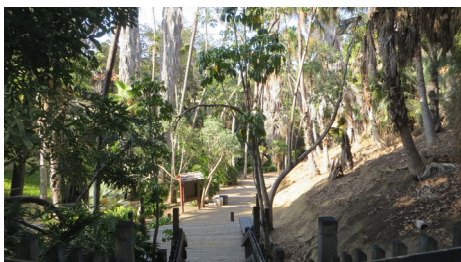
The hall will be open to the community beginning Thursday November 1st 2018 to Sunday November 4th 2018.

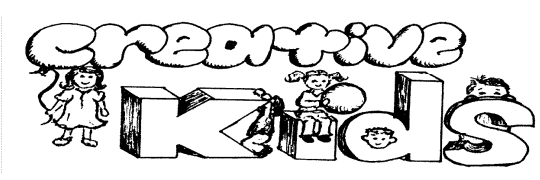

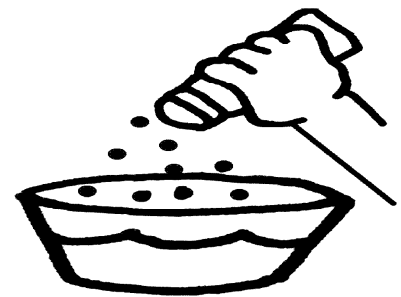
Directions: Change one letter in the word BLIND to make a new word with the clues given. Then write it on the line.

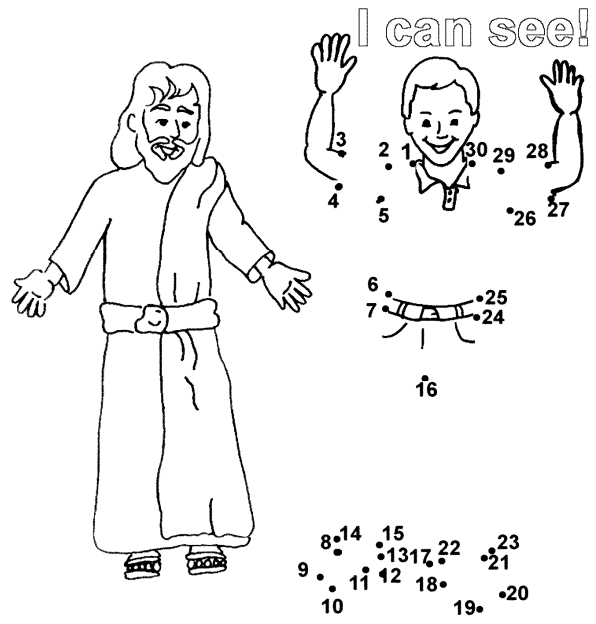
